WHAT IS A NEWBORN CARE SPECIALIST?

A Newborn Care Specialist (also known as a "Baby Nurse") is someone who specializes in newborn care. Newborn Care Specialists assist parents in their home the first few weeks or months of a baby's life with parent education, feeding/breastfeeding, basic baby care, nursery organization, and cleanliness. It is important to note that a Newborn Care Specialist is neither a Nanny nor a Doula and requires special training and education specific to the profession. If you love babies this is the training for you!

WHAT IS A POSTPARTUM DOULA?

Postpartum Doulas: an experienced woman who is skilled in caring for women and their families in the postpartum period. She provides moral, physical, educational and emotional support at a time when women need "mothering". The new mother is the primary focus. She is trained in newborn assessment, mother/baby care, breast and/or bottle-feeding, breast pump instruction, sibling care, postpartum blues, depression, and psychosis.

WHAT IS A NANNY?

Nannies: A nanny is responsible for the children's physical, emotional, and psychological well-being. Their responsibilities are limited to those duties in a household that are executed for the children. A Nanny may have formal training in child development, or many years of experience. They usually work unsupervised and domestic tasks are limited to those for the children such as laundry and keeping their rooms tidy.

WHAT WILL I LEARN IN THIS TRAINING?
